

Memo from Buildings & Grounds Comm. on Club repairs/improvements needed

EROSION OF STREAM BED

We will need a plan to limit or stop floods from washing away the road beyond the bridge on the lower range. Bd. members are asked to inspect conditions and make recommendations.

There will be lists of large and small jobs posted in the club house and on the web site. I will be asking for volunteer project managers to accomplish these tasks, using labor from new member work parties.

A list of some of the jobs to follow:

Main parking lot:

1. barrier around propane tanks
2. fence off skeet field and club house entrance
3. repair/replace barrier fence by skeet house and trap field
4. privacy fence between wobble field and neighbors property

CLUB HOUSE

1. new roof?
2. paint?
3. repair/replace air conditioners
4. locked mailbox for Bd & Officers?
5. clean out rear room (xerox machine, lockers)
6. repair/replace wall outlets not working
7. new electric outlet for youth safe
8. replace light fixture youth safe room
9. filters and mountings needed for both furnace rooms
10. weather stripping rear clubhouse door needed

11. utility sink needed in rear room

INDOOR RANGE

The indoor range needs constant maintenance, Paul Bennech and Steve Sandow check and repair weekly.

1. check and replace light bulbs
2. remove lead suggest quarterly (March, June, September & December)
3. level and straighten all tracks
4. replace broken parts carriers 6 & 7
5. replace electric motor position 4
6. replace broken parts on shelves and shooting barriers
7. replace exit light left side
8. paint and repair rear walls
9. need racks for cardboard backers
10. remove plywood and steel plates right side
11. clean and repaint floors
12. request professional help for heat and ventilation

Help is needed for maintenance on weekly basis, call if you are available Monday, Tuesday evening, Wednesday 2:30 PM, second and fourth Sundays of each month 1:30 to 4:00 PM.

RIFLE RANGE

1. safety range?
2. barrier between rifle range and pistol range
3. dirt needed to level 100 yard range so water will drain beyond 50 yard berm

4. dirt needed at 25 yard target (see above)
5. target material and backers presently stored in white shed
6. electric service needed at rifle range (power from green shed where panel located)
7. restore backstop at 100 yard range
8. replace walkway from bench rest to 100 yard berm

BULLS EYE PISTOL RANGE

1. 25 yard barrier needs to be replaced
2. all target holders at 25 & 50 yards need to be serviced (painting and minor repairs)

PPC RANGE

1. remove limbs from pine tree leaning on white shed
2. level road way
3. replace door on white shed
4. repair and paint green IDPA shed
5. check and inventory steel targets stored in white shed (\$2000 worth of silhouettes)
6. secure box needed for silhouette targets they have been found lying around club grounds

GARAGE

1. repair exterior and replace overhead door

Since many of these jobs will be needing board approval for funds, if you agree to help I will arrange funding.

Board members and officers, club members and chairs of disciplines are asked to submit additional projects that need to be accomplished. You are also requested to take on the range needs your group uses
